

Library Code of Conduct

Behaviour

The library is a public place that is accessible to everyone. We welcome users to our facility with the following guidelines:

- Patrons who causes excessive disruption will be warned, and then asked to leave if their behavior continues
- Patrons must wear a shirt and footwear to enter
- Patrons will not consume food at the public computers
- Patrons will not leave garbage in the meeting room or public areas
- Patrons will abide by the computer usage guidelines
- Patrons will abide by all public health ordinances

Youth

The library welcomes unaccompanied youth who are independent enough to use the library with the following guidelines:

- Library staff will not provide supervision or care of unaccompanied youth
- Parents must provide appropriate supervision based on the maturity of their children
- Youth who cause excessive disruption or who require excessive staff attention will be warned, then asked to leave if inappropriate behaviour continues
- If a child is asked to leave the library, an attempt to notify the parents will be made, and if necessary, parents will be asked to stay with their children for future visits
- Parents must be aware of the library's opening and closing time and that operating hours may change unexpectedly, if a child remains at closing time, the police may be called
- Any patrons under 16 must have the permission of a guardian to use the public computers
